Description

The method **count** returns count of how many times *obj* occurs in list.

Syntax

Following is the syntax for **count** method –

```
list.count(obj)
```

Parameters

- **obj** -- This is the object to be counted in the list.

Return Value

This method returns count of how many times *obj* occurs in list.

Example

The following example shows the usage of count method.

```
#!/usr/bin/python  
  
aList = [123, 'xyz', 'zara', 'abc', 123];  
  
print "Count for 123 : ", aList.count(123)  
print "Count for zara : ", aList.count('zara')
```

When we run above program, it produces following result –

```
Count for 123 : 2  
Count for zara : 1
```
