
■ Burt, Fern, and Kirk were in the park. It was the perfect day for a picnic!




How did these friends have fun at their picnic? Let's follow them and find out.



First, Burt fixed a sandwich. He used a tortilla, which is Mexican. Look at the way he curls it up.




- Burt cut his tortilla into thirds. He offered it to Fern and Kirk.

it up.




- Fern cut her sandwich into thirds. She offered some to Burt and Kirk.
