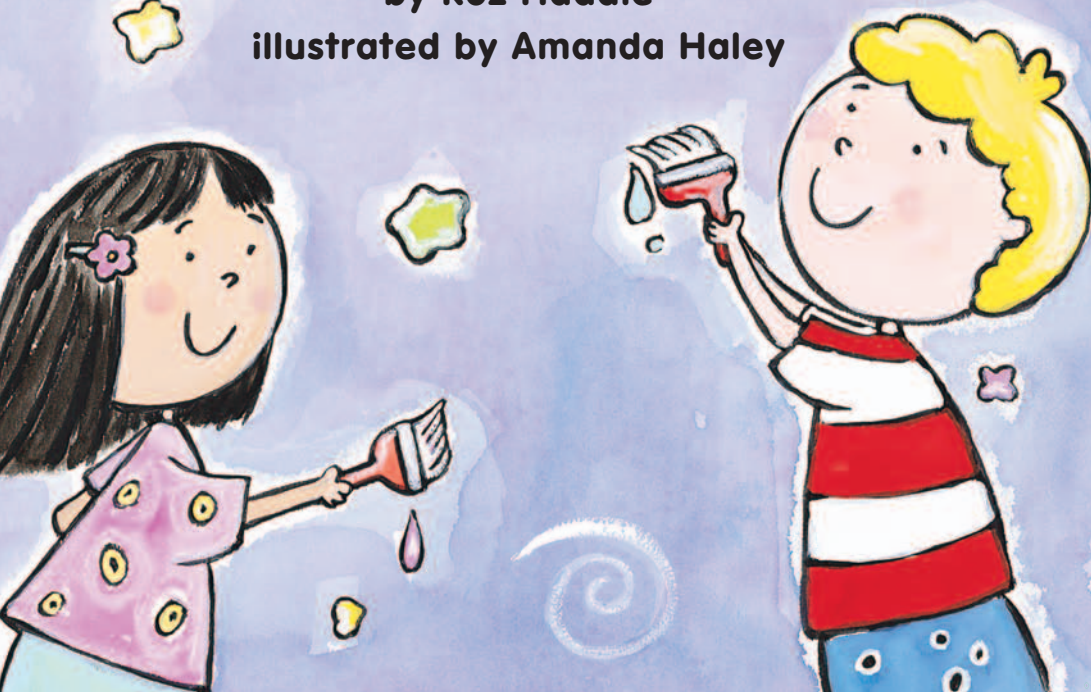

it is not simple.



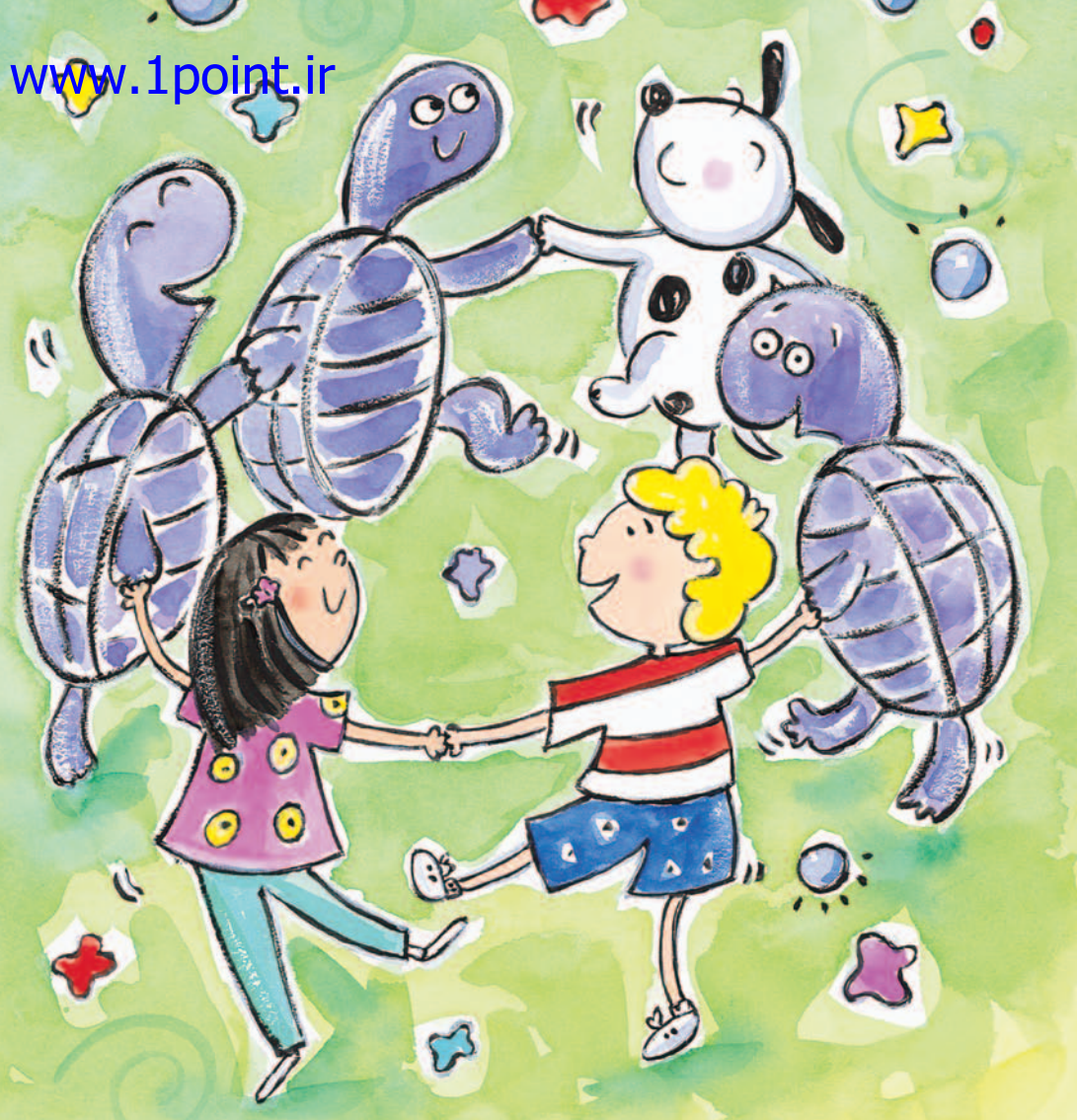
▶ “This takes forever,” grumbles Pat. He cannot smile.



Now school is set up. “How about some friends to share it with?” asks Carla.








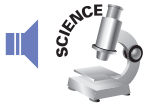
▶ “Great,” says Pat. The kids sketch and talk together. What is possible in this school?
