## Description

The method **sort** sorts objects of list, use compare *func* if given.

## Syntax

Following is the syntax for **sort** method –

```
list.sort([func])
```

## Parameters

## Return Value

This method does not return any value but reverse the given object from the list.

## Example

The following example shows the usage of sort method.

```
#!/usr/bin/python  
aList = [123, 'xyz', 'zara', 'abc', 'xyz'];  
aList.sort();  
print "List : ", aList
```

When we run above program, it produces following result –

```
List : [123, 'abc', 'xyz', 'xyz', 'zara']
