

This problem is mainly caused by some gases like carbon dioxide. There is too much carbon

dioxide in the air. When oil, gas, or coal burn, they create large amounts of CO2.

We send five billion tons of carbon dioxide into the atmosphere every year. This carbon dioxide lets sunlight enter the Earth's atmosphere and heat the Earth. However, it does not let as much heat leave the atmosphere and enter space. It is like a blanket – a thick cloth used to keep us warm when we are sleep.
