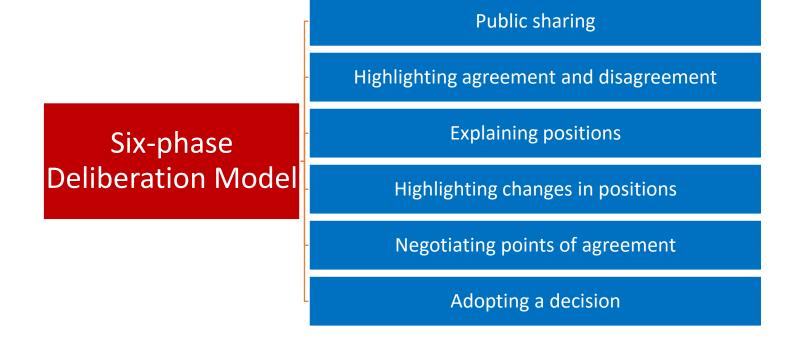

constructing contexts for the focuses

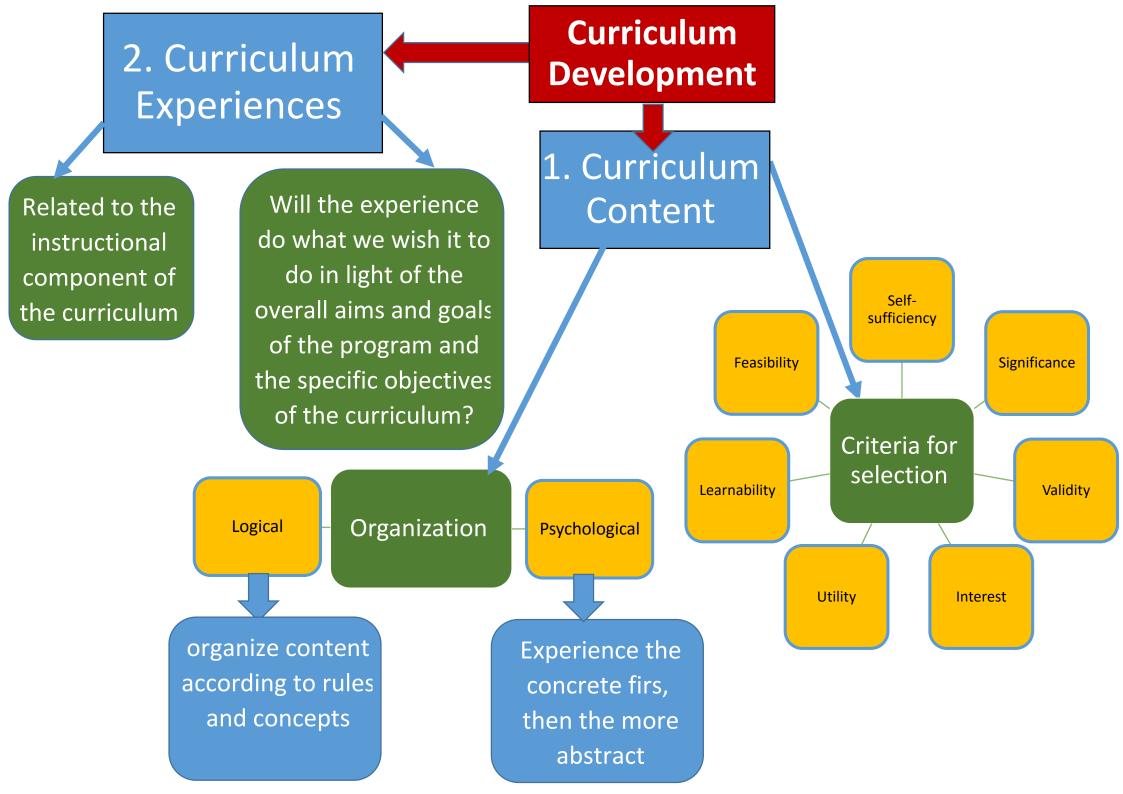
Postmodern Models Detachment from conventional procedures
