

Puss in Boots



'But I'm a poor man,' says Daniel. 'I can't buy presents for the King.'




'No,' says his cat. 'But we can catch some fish for the King.'

'Quickly, Daniel, jump into the river!' he says.


'I can't jump into the river,' says Daniel. 'I can't swim!'




'Look! The King's coming in his coach,' says Puss in Boots. 'He can help you.'

'Help! Please help!' says Puss in Boots. 'Lord Carabas is in the river and he can't swim!'


'Stop the coach!' says the King.

'That's an excellent idea,' says Puss in Boots. 'Lord Carabas's castle is over there. I can go to the castle and make tea for everyone!'




Puss in Boots goes to the ugly Ogre's castle. He knocks on the door.




The Ogre frightens Puss in Boots.

'You can't eat me!' says the Ogre. 'Small cats can't eat big Ogres!'


'No, of course small cats can't eat big Ogres,' says Puss in Boots.
