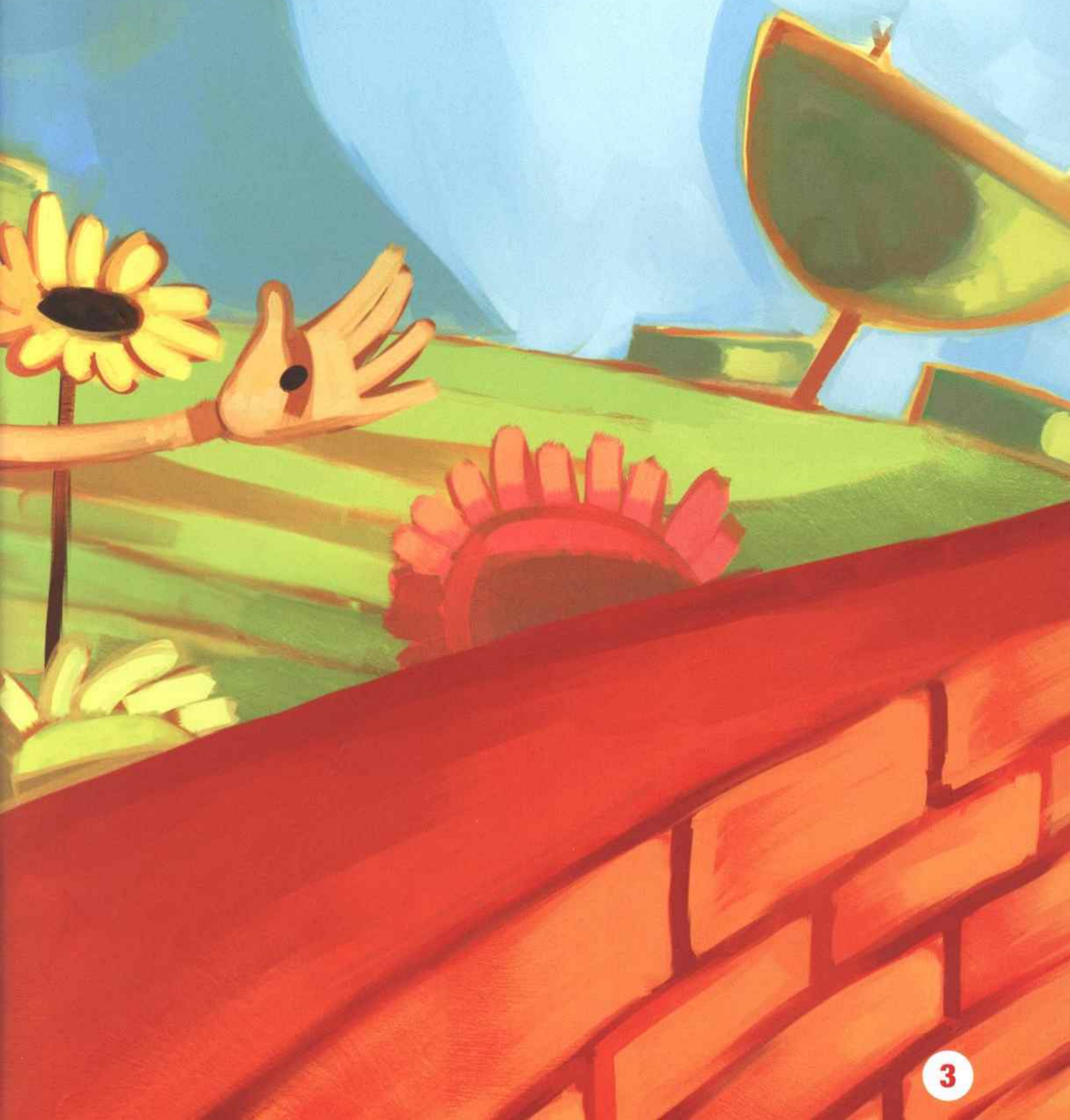


The Enormous Turnip

He puts the seed into the earth and goes to bed.



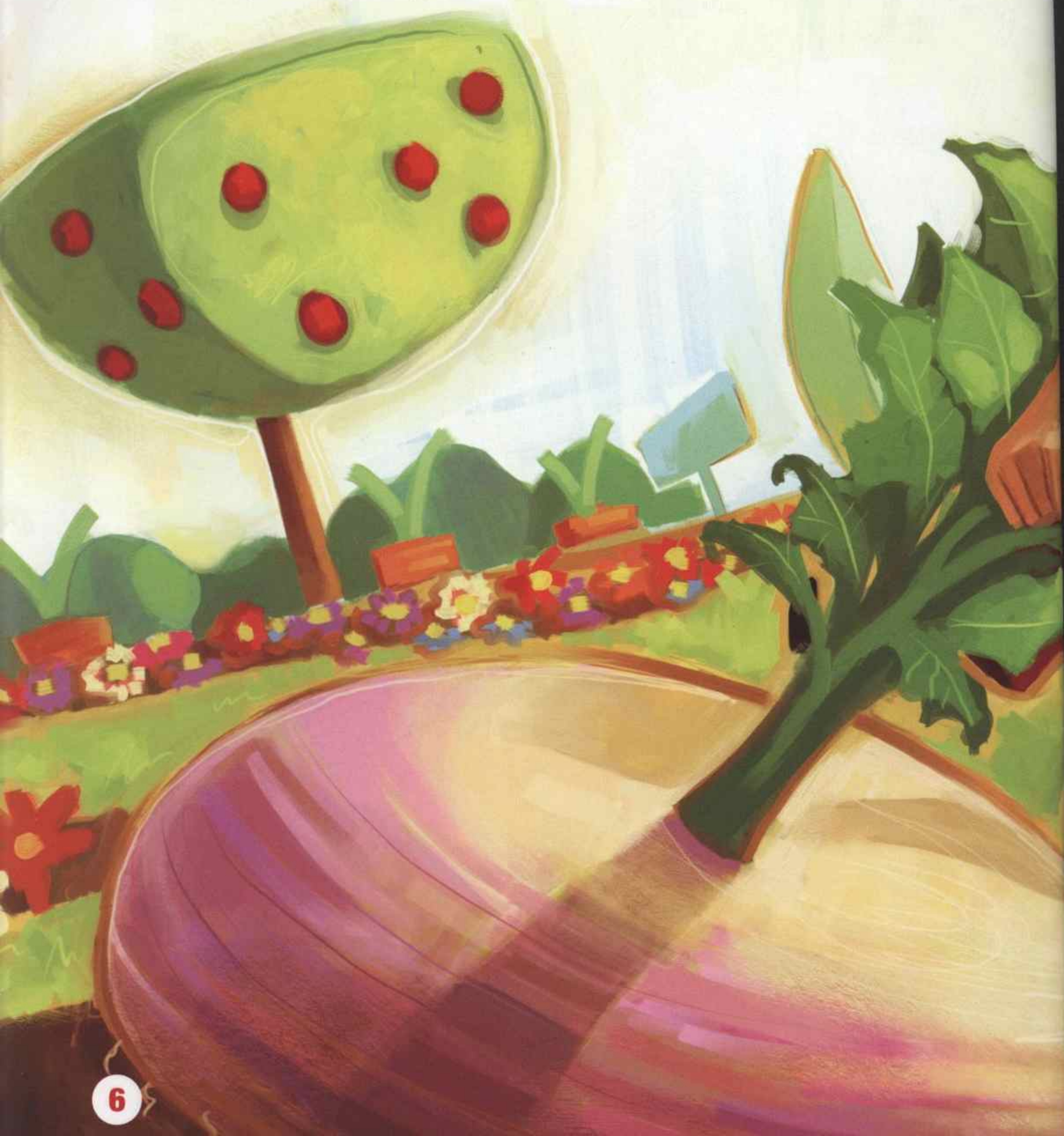
In the night the turnip grows

It's ENORMOUS!

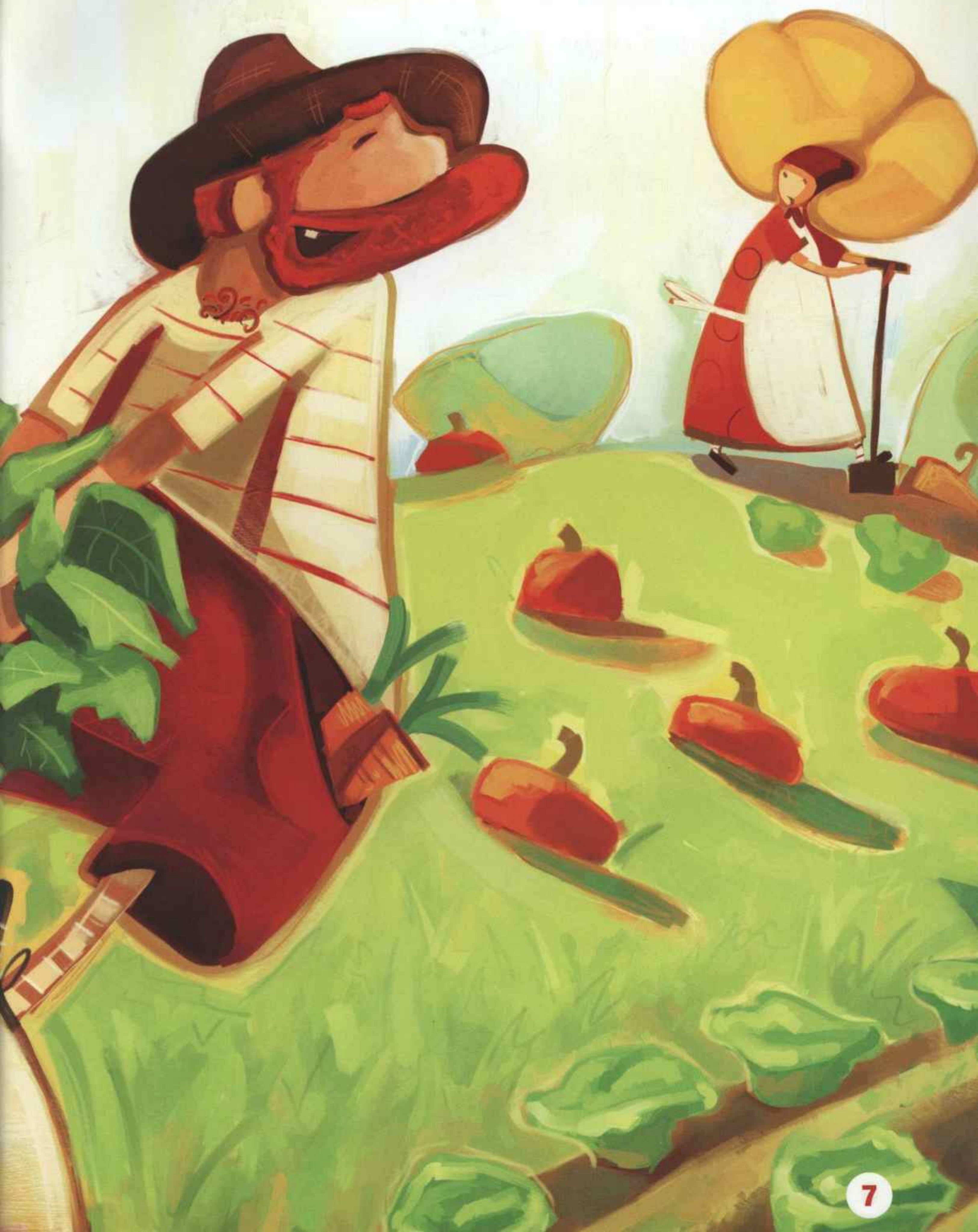


In the morning Mr Johnson is in the garden.

The little mouse looks at Mr Johnson and his family.

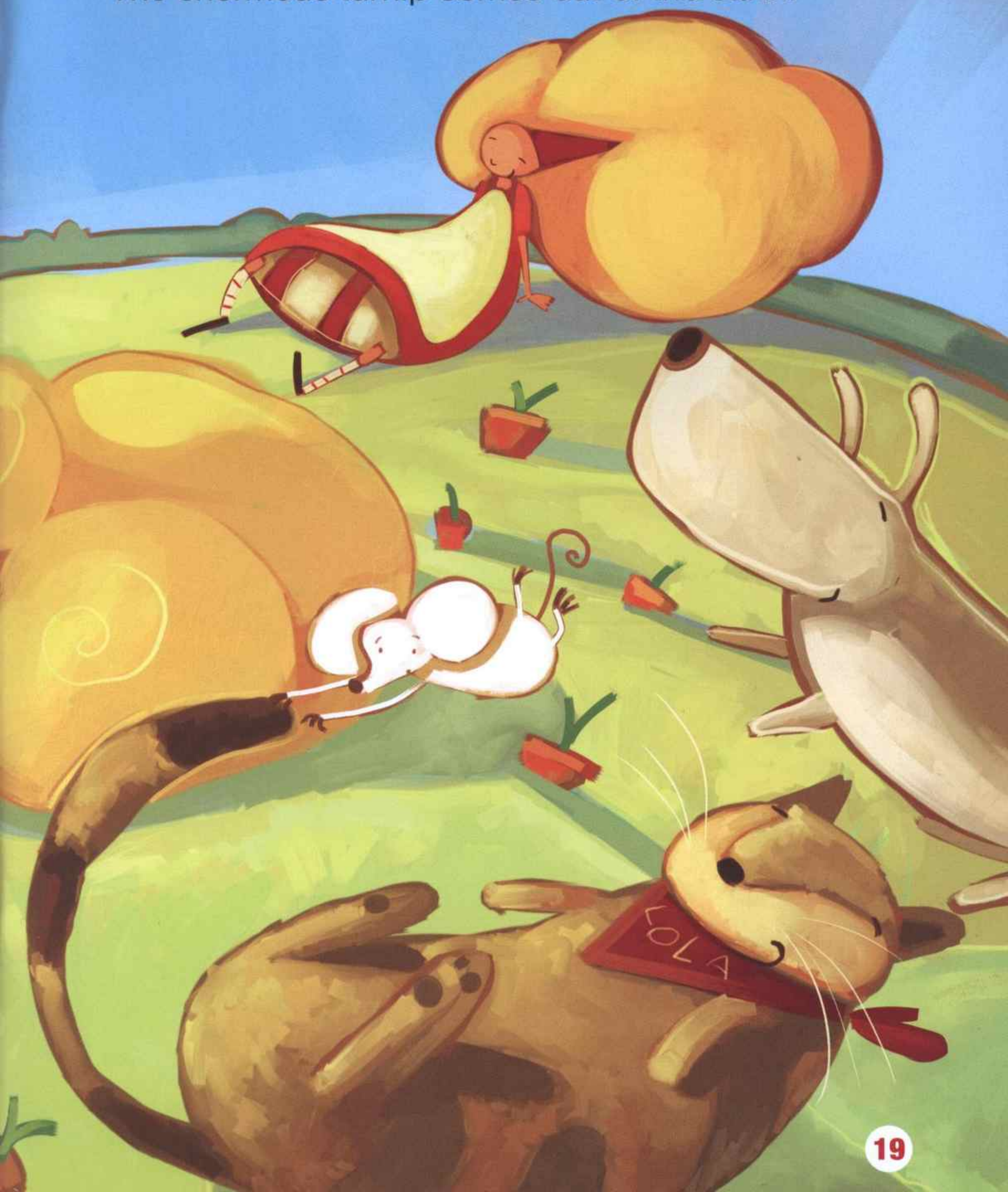


Mr Johnson calls the mouse.

The enormous turnip comes out of the earth!



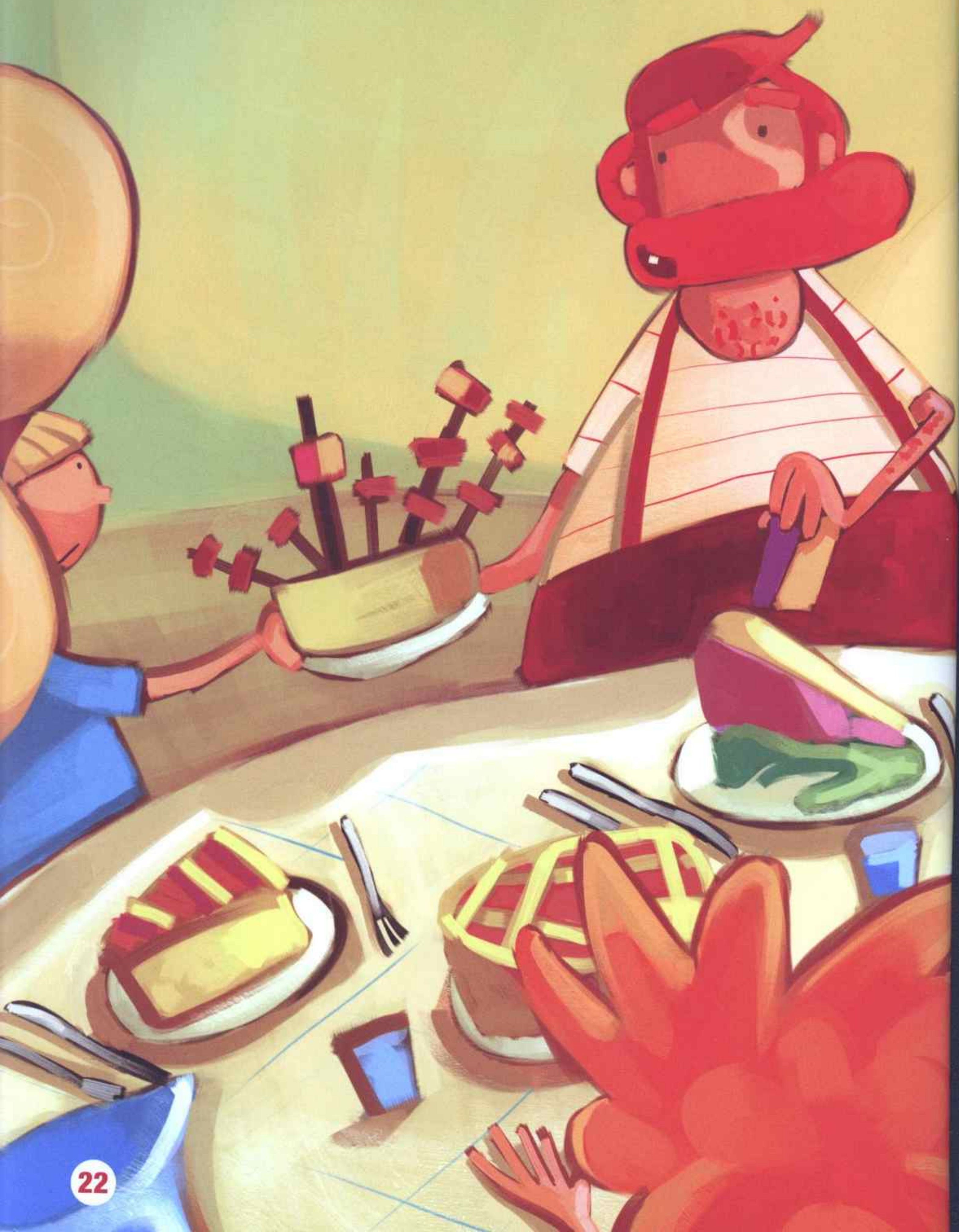
Mrs Johnson says, 'Come and help me cook this wonderful, enormous turnip!'

She goes into the house with Mr Johnson, her son Ben, her daughter Katie, her dog Pip, her cat Lola and the little white mouse.

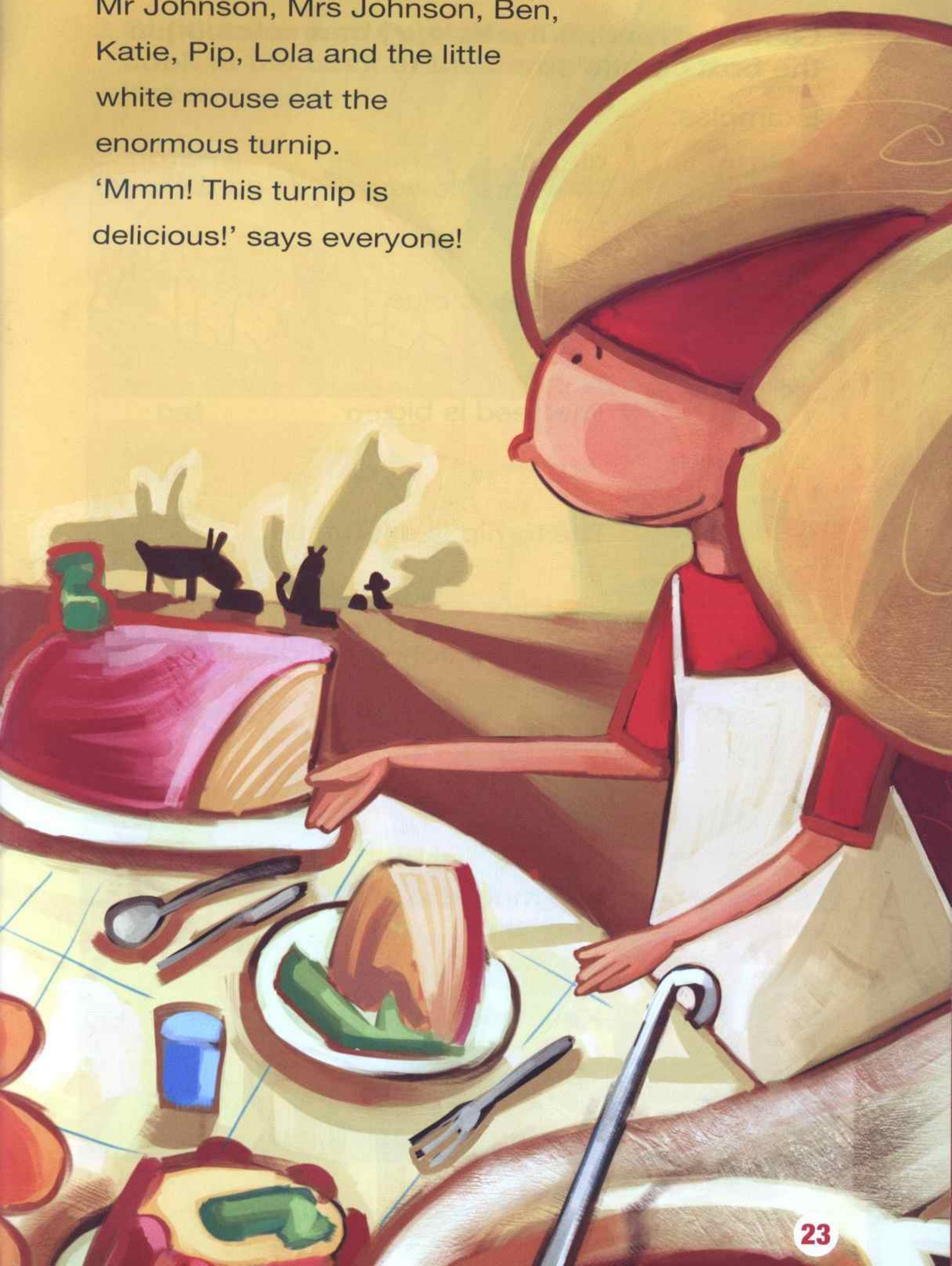


Mr Johnson, Ben, Katie, Pip, Lola and the little white mouse help Mrs Johnson cook the enormous turnip.
