compel:to force someone to do something

The law will compel employers to provide health insurance.

She felt compelled to resign because of the scandal.



discretion:the ability and right to decide exactly what should be done in a particular situation

The awards are made at the discretion of the committee.

Troopers have discretion in deciding whom to stop for speeding.



resolve: to solve or end a problem or difficulty

The couple resolved their differences.

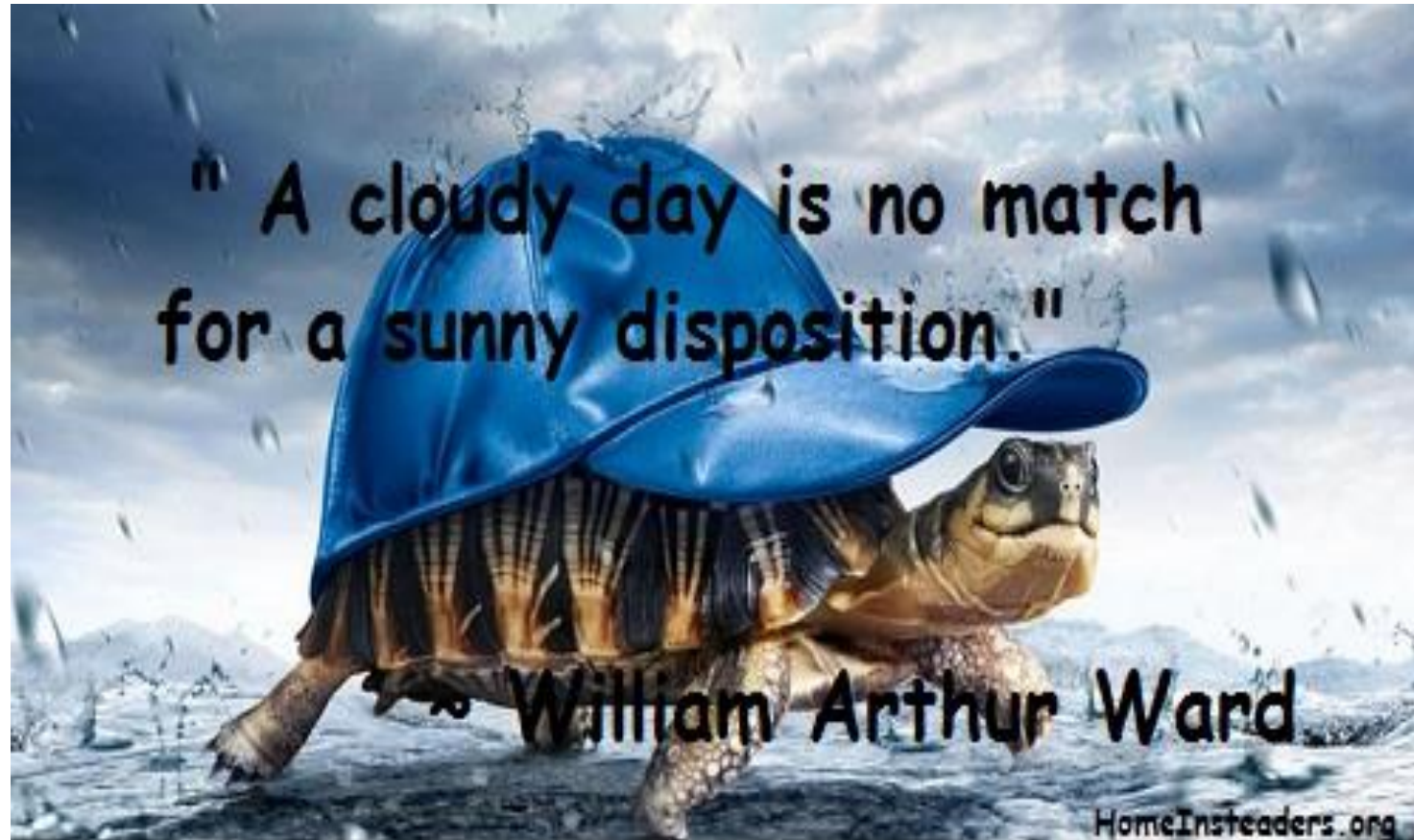
His speech did nothing to resolve doubts about the company's future.



disposition: خو و مزاج، تمایل

Her disposition was to always think negatively.

He has a disposition toward criminal behavior.



evolve: to change or develop slowly often into a better

The company has evolved over the years into a multi-million dollar organization

Most languages are constantly evolving and changing, which is what keeps them alive

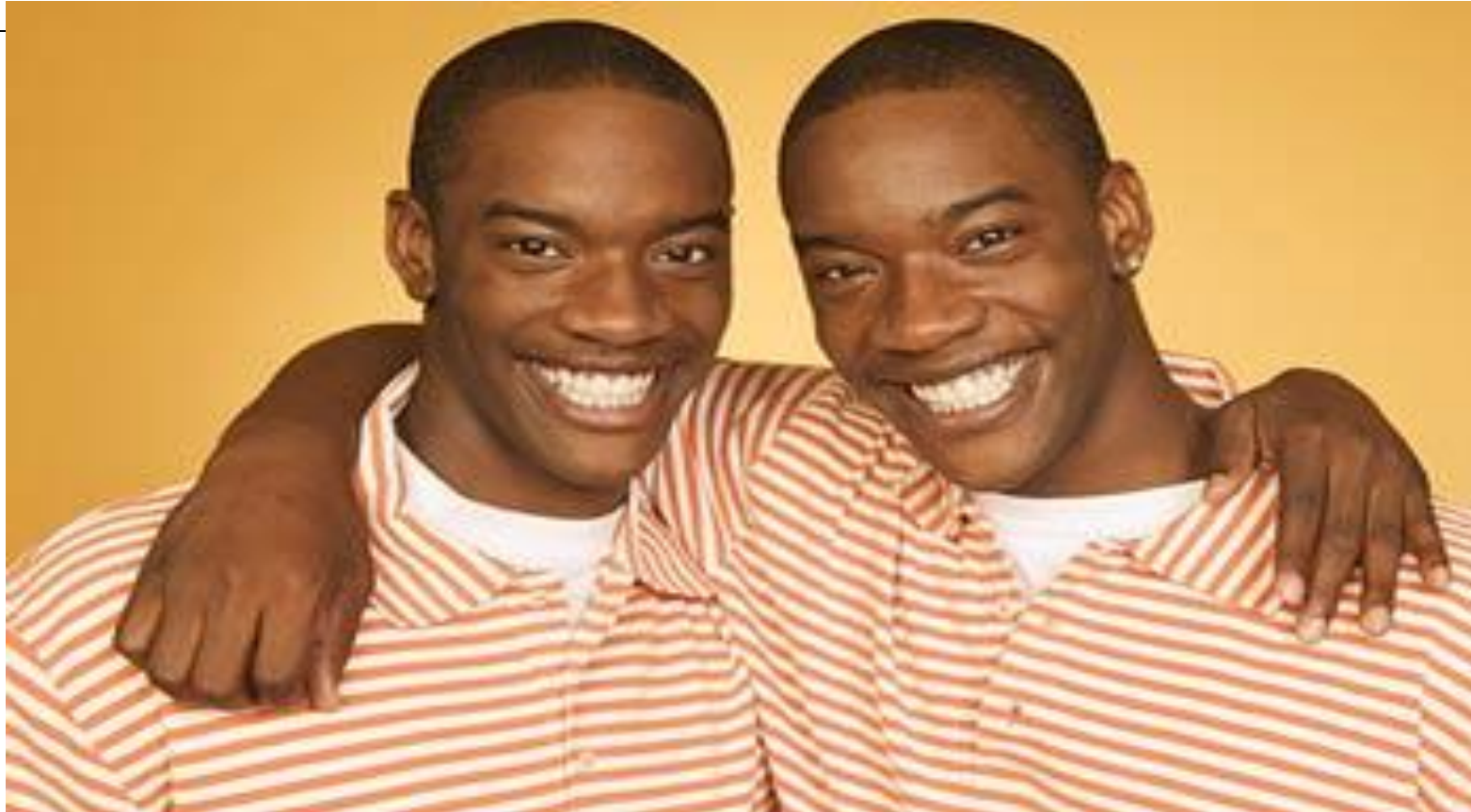


identical: exactly the same, or very similar

propel:to push or drive (someone or something)

forward هل دادن ، به جلو دادن

a jet engine propels the rocket

boundary disputes propelled the two countries toward

expenditure: مخارج، هزينه‌ها:

an increase in military expenditures



diligent:hard working; industrious

They made diligent efforts to carry out their programs

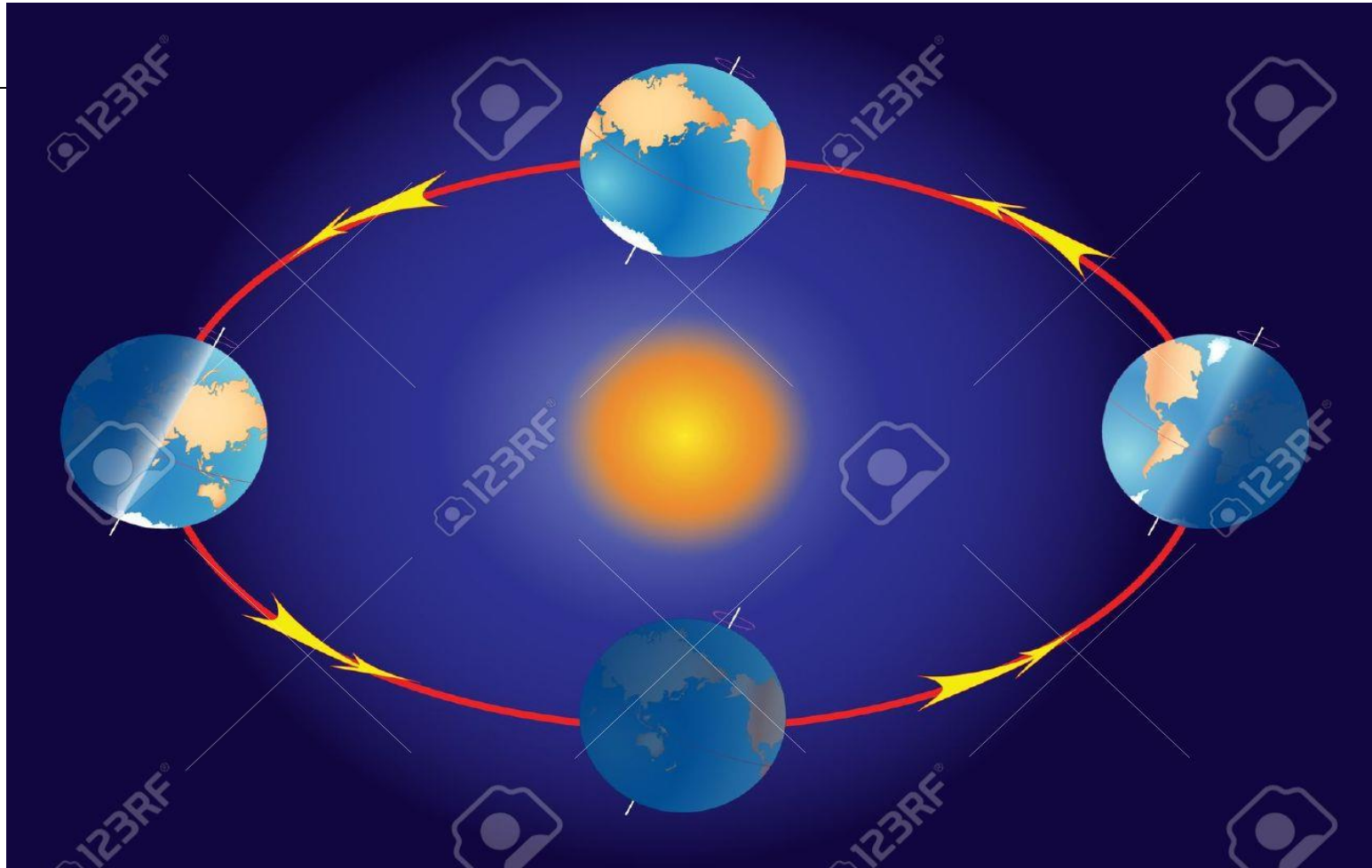
Their lawyer was extremely diligent in preparing their case.



revolve:to turn around a center point or line ، چرخیدن،
گشتن، گردیدن

the earth also revolves on its own axis

His life revolves around (= He is only interested in)
football.



substantial: large in size, value, or importance

They do a substantial portion of their business by phone.

We have the support of a substantial number of parents.



summon: (برای شرکت در جلسه) فراخواندن، دعوت کردن

The president summoned an emergency meeting of his advisers.

I have been summoned to appear in court.



demolish: to completely destroy

A number of houses were demolished so that the supermarket could be built.

Tons of explosives were used to demolish the building.



depict: to represent or show something in a picture, story, movie, etc.; portray

The movie depicts his father as a tyrant..

Angels are usually depicted with wings.



detach:to separate or remove something from something else that it is connected to

She has been trying to detach herself from an abusive relationship.

You can detach the hood if you prefer the coat without it.



illuminate(i'lu:.mi:neɪt): 1/to light something and make it brighter

The streets were illuminated with strings of coloured lights

2/If you illuminate a subject, you explain it

This article illuminates the basic principles of economics.



incidence: an event, or the rate at which something happens

an increased incidence of cancer near nuclear power stations

a high incidence of criminal behavior
