

- to come up with : to find ; to discover. « تا فتن »

Ex: After worrying for days, I finally come up with a solution to my answer problem.

- on purpose : deliberately ; intentionally. « عمداً »

Ex: He broke my glasses on purpose.

- so far : up to now ; as of yet « تا حالا »

Ex: How many idioms have we learnt in this course so far ?

- get over : to recover from an illness. « بهبود یافتن »

Ex: It took me over a month to get over my cold.

- to make up one's mind : to decide finally. « در نهایت تصمیم گرفتن »

Ex: When are you going to make up your mind about the subject of your dissertation ?

- to change one's mind : to alter one's decision. « تغییر تصمیم »

Ex: We have changed our mind and are going to Kish instead of Shiraz for vacation.

- to call off : to cancel « لغو کردن »

Ex: The referee called off the soccer game because of the rain.

- to put off : postpone ; delay « به تأخیر انداختن »

Ex: Many students put off doing their assignments until the last minute.

- out of order : out of service ; not in working condition. « خراب »

Ex: The elevator was out of order, so we had to walk to the 10th floor.

- ahead of time : before a scheduled time. « قبل از موعد »

Ex: I knew ahead of time that Ali was coming to dinner, so I cooked extra food.

- over and over again: repeatedly; time and again.

Ex: The actress studied her lines over and over again until she knew them well.

- to be in charge of: to have responsibility for « مسئول بودن »

Ex: Saeed is in charge of the office while his boss is on a trip.

- in no time: very quickly; rapidly

Ex: John said that he would be ready to leave in no time.

- to cut down on sth: reduce; decrease « کاهش دادن »

Ex: In order to lose weight, you have to cut down on your intake of sugar.

- out of the question: impossible « غیر ممکن بودن »

Ex: Taking vacation now is out of the question since we have to study for the exam.

- feel like doing sth. « حس کاری / داشتن / (don't) داشتن »

Ex: I feel like going to a movie tonight.

- once in a blue moon: rarely « به ندرت »

Ex: Snow falls on the city of Dezfoul once in a blue moon.

- to go overboard: to get carried away « جوگیر شدن »

Ex: James went overboard while shopping for his wife's birthday. He spent too much money.

- It stands to reason that ... : It is clear and logical that

«واضح و برهنه است که»

Ex: It stands to reason that a person without experience cannot do the work as well as an experienced one.

- to take for granted : to assume to be true.

Ex: He spoke English so well that I took it for granted he was an American.

- to call it a day : to stop

Ex: Ehsan tried to repair his car engine all morning before he called it a day and went home.

- get along with : to associate or work well with.
