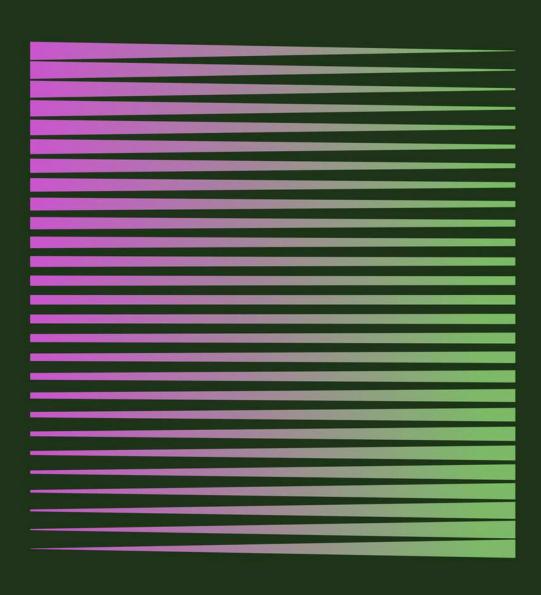
# How to use ChatGPT... in academic research



## 1. Creating synthesis

#### First send ChatGPT the abstracts or introductions most relevant to your paper.

You will act as a university professor in accounting. I will first share three studies and you will acknowledge receipt. Once you have acknowledged receipt, I will ask you questions about the studies I shared.

#### Then ask for a comprehensive summary for each study.

For each study, describe the purpose and findings, as well as benefits and pitfalls of their approach. Create some of tension in your argumentation.

#### You can be more specific, too.

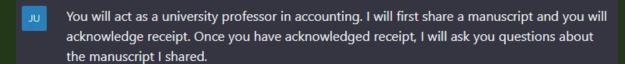

## 2. Identify style

#### First submit your favorite introduction to ChatGPT.

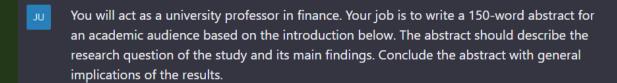
