Do the activities A and B [farm animals / wild animals] or [animals living on land / animals living in the sea]

Whale: It is a very large animal which lives in the sea and looks like a fish but is actually a mammal.(A whale blows a jet of spray high in the air)

beached whale =stranded whale

Elephant: It is a very large grey animal with four legs, two tusks (long curved teeth) and a trunk (long nose) that it can use to pick things up.

Panda: a large black and white animal that looks like a bear and lives in the mountains of China.

Cheetah=a member of cat family that has long legs and black spots on its fur and can run extremely fast

Leopard=a large animal of the cat family with yellow fur and black spots which lives in Africa and South Asia

(A leopard can't change its spots)

Wolf >wolves: a wild animal that looks like a large dog and lives and hunts in groups

(a wolf in sheep's clothing)

Goat: an animal that has horns on top of its head and long hair under its chin, and can climb steep hills and rocks. Goats live wild in the mountains or are kept as farm animals

Billy goat (m)=/=nanny goat (f)

Wild animals =/= farm animals/domestic animals

Duck: a very common water bird with short legs and a wide beak ,used for its meat , eggs , and soft feathers

A duck quacks /waddles/paddles/dives/bobs

A duck pond: a small area of water where there are ducks

Cat: a small animal with four legs that people often keep as a pet.

When the cat 's away, the mice will play

Tiger: a large wild animal that has yellow and black lines on its body and is a member of the cat family

Proverb: the tiger cannot change its stripes. One can't change one's essential nature. For example, He's a conservative, no matter what he says; the leopard cannot change its spots.

Lion: A large animal of the cat family that lives in Africa and parts of Southern Asia.Lions have gold-coloured fur and the male has a mane (long hair around its neck ياك)

The lion's den: if you go into the lion's den, you go among people who are your enemies

The lion's share of sth: the largest part of sth [e.g. The firm has captured the lion's share of the UK market.]

oviparous :تخم گذار an animal , a fish , a bird etc that is oviparous produces eggs that develop outside its body

mammal : a type of animal that drinks milk from its mother's body when it is young . humans , dogs and whales are mammals.

Carnivorous : گوشتخوار : an animal that eats flesh

(humorous به مزاح)someone who eats meat

Herbivorous: an animal that only eats plants

Vegetarian:someone who does not eat meat or fish
