





Amanda cuts her finger while she is eating some fruits. Read the conversation between Daniel and Amanda. Amanda does not understand some facts about blood. Help her to understand well.



Daniel: More than half of the blood is plasma. This is a clear, pale yellow liquid, which carries all the blood cells and platelets and chemicals such as hormones and glucose.

Amanda: What do they do?

Daniel: Red blood cells carry oxygen around the body, and collect carbon dioxide and take it back to the lungs where it can be sent out. There are millions of red blood cells in one small drop of blood.

Amanda: Wow! Why are they red?!

Daniel: These cells are red because they have a red-colored chemical called hemoglobin. Red blood cells are being made all of the time in the bone marrow inside many bones of the body. They live for about 4 months, then they are broken up and much of the contents are used to make new blood cells.

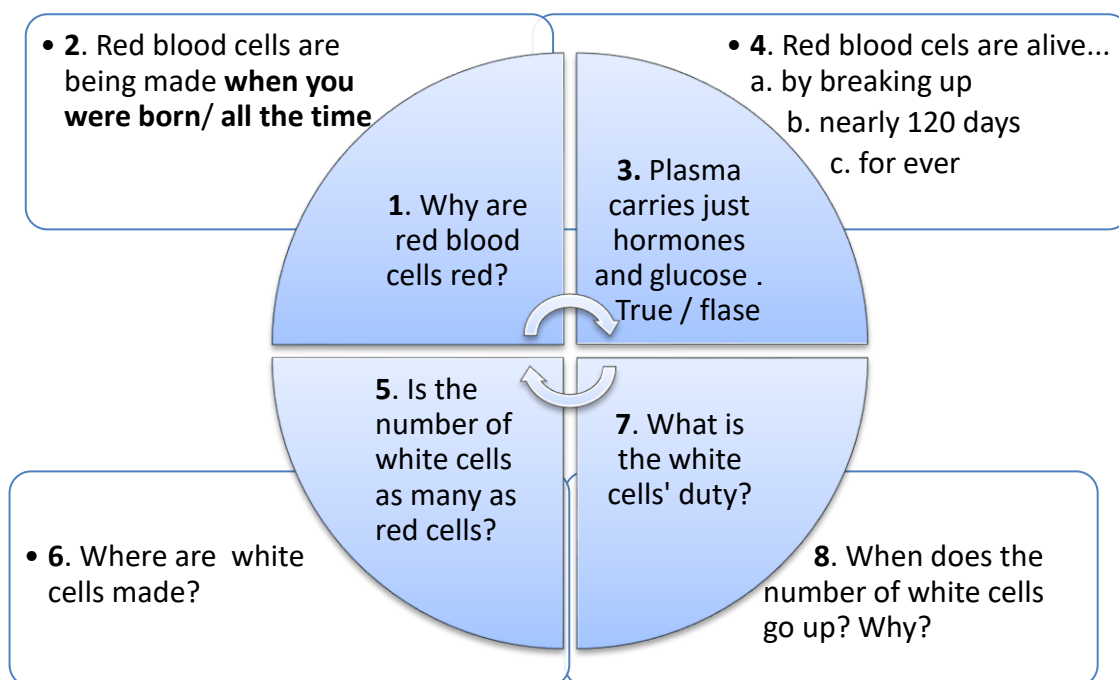
Amanda: Are all the cells in blood red?






Daniel: Oh, no! White blood cells are white.

Amanda: Do they carry oxygen, too?



Daniel: No. They defend the body against microbes and foreign bodies. There are normally around 5,000 to 7,000 white cells in a milliliter of blood, but the number of white cells goes up a lot when you are sick.
