

<p>Before Edit</p>	<p>Barley is a major food in several regions of the world and it is generally found in regions where other cereals do not grow up well due to altitude, low precipitation, or soil salinity. It remains the most viable option in dry areas (<300mm of rainfall). Food barley is used either for bread making (usually mixed with bread wheat) or for specific recipes [13]. Total production of barley was about 3 million tons in Iran and cultivated area was about 1.68 million hectare during 2009 [31]. Share of cultivated dryland barley was 57% and irrigated barley was 43% in this year. Lorestan province has the third gain in barley production in Iran. In this province cultivated area of barley was about 9029 and 129949 ha as irrigated and dryland production systems in 2009, respectively [3].</p>
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
