Forest: A large area of land that is covered with trees

Thick / dense / rain / tropical forest

Not see the forest for the trees: to be unable to understand what is important in a situation because you are thinking too much about small details rather than the whole situation

Destroy= ruin- demolish – to damage sth so badly that it no longer exists or cannot be used or repaired [destroyer, destruction (noun)]

[destructive (adj) destructively (adv)]

Destroy forests/houses/enemies/cities

Jungle: a thick tropical forest with many large plants growing very close together; the Amazon jungle (used in Longman dic. The Amazon rainforest used in all other sources)

Die out=To disappear or stop existing=extinct

The wild population of Koalasis in danger of dying out

Pay attention: to carefully listen to , look at or think about sth or someone

Natural=existing in nature. Not caused ,made or controlled by people =/= man-made, artificial

Zebra: An animal that looks like a horse but has black and white lines all over its body

Natural home= habitat

Plain: A large area of flat dry land

Hope: Want sth to happen [She hopes to finish her homework soon]

Injured= having a wound or damage to part of your body

A few:not many – a small number of things or people

[There ARE a few Iranian CheetahS.

Human: a person [All humans must take care of nature]

Instead: in place of someone or sth else

[There is NO coffee There is N'T ANY coffee. Would you like a cup of tea instead?]

Future: the time after now ** in the near future / at some time in the future
