

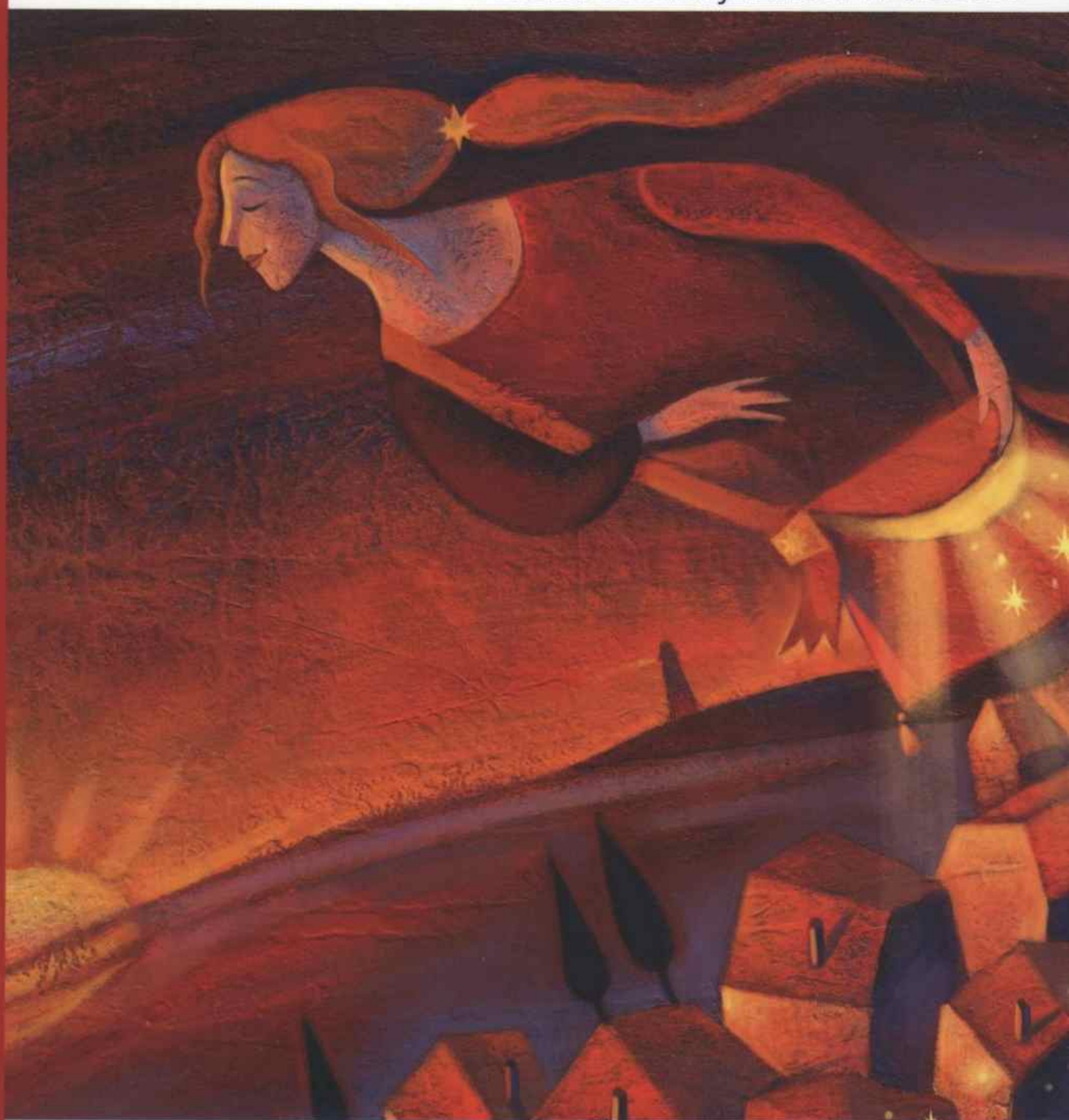

Here comes Dorothy.

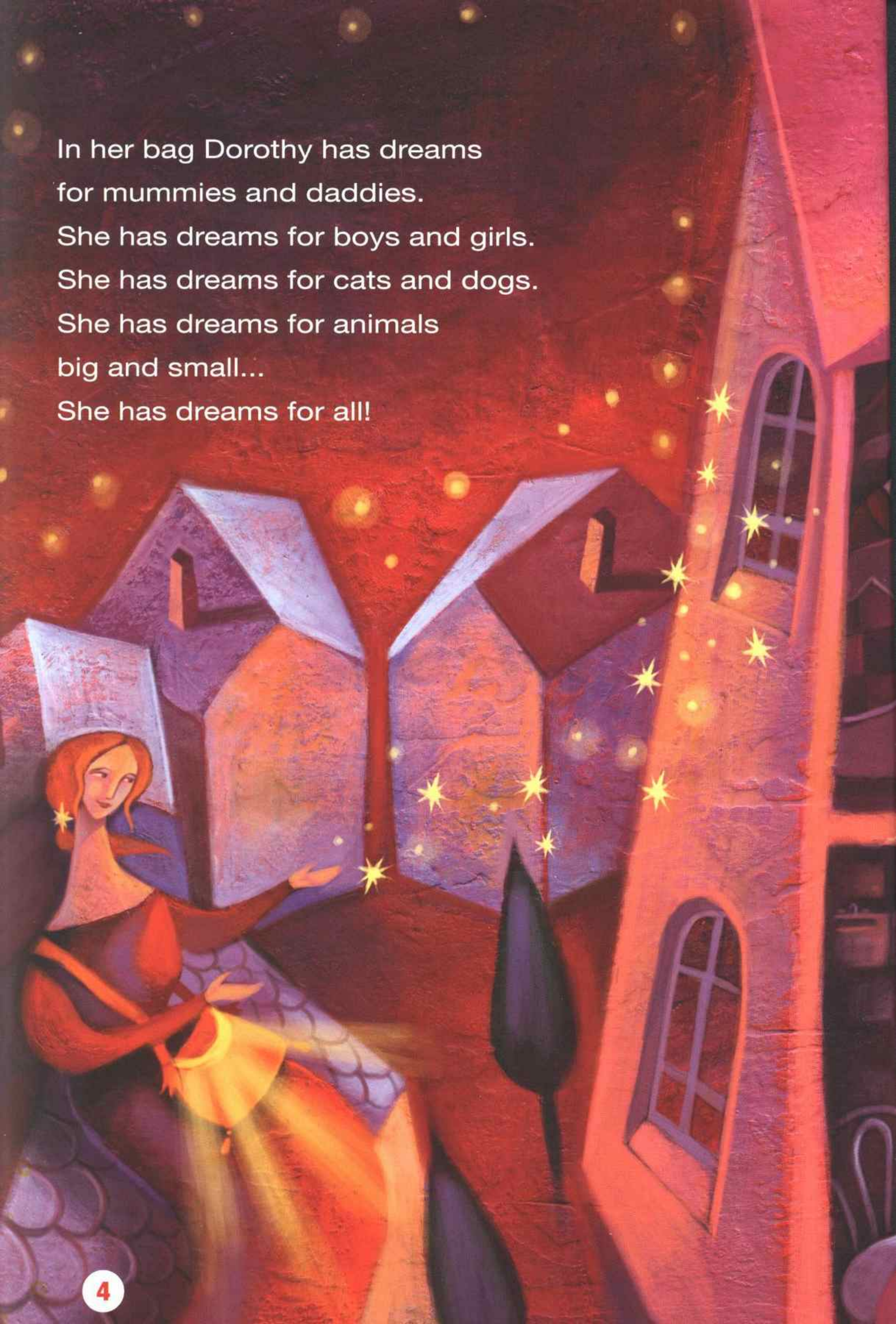
She has a big bag.

But big, dark clouds come.

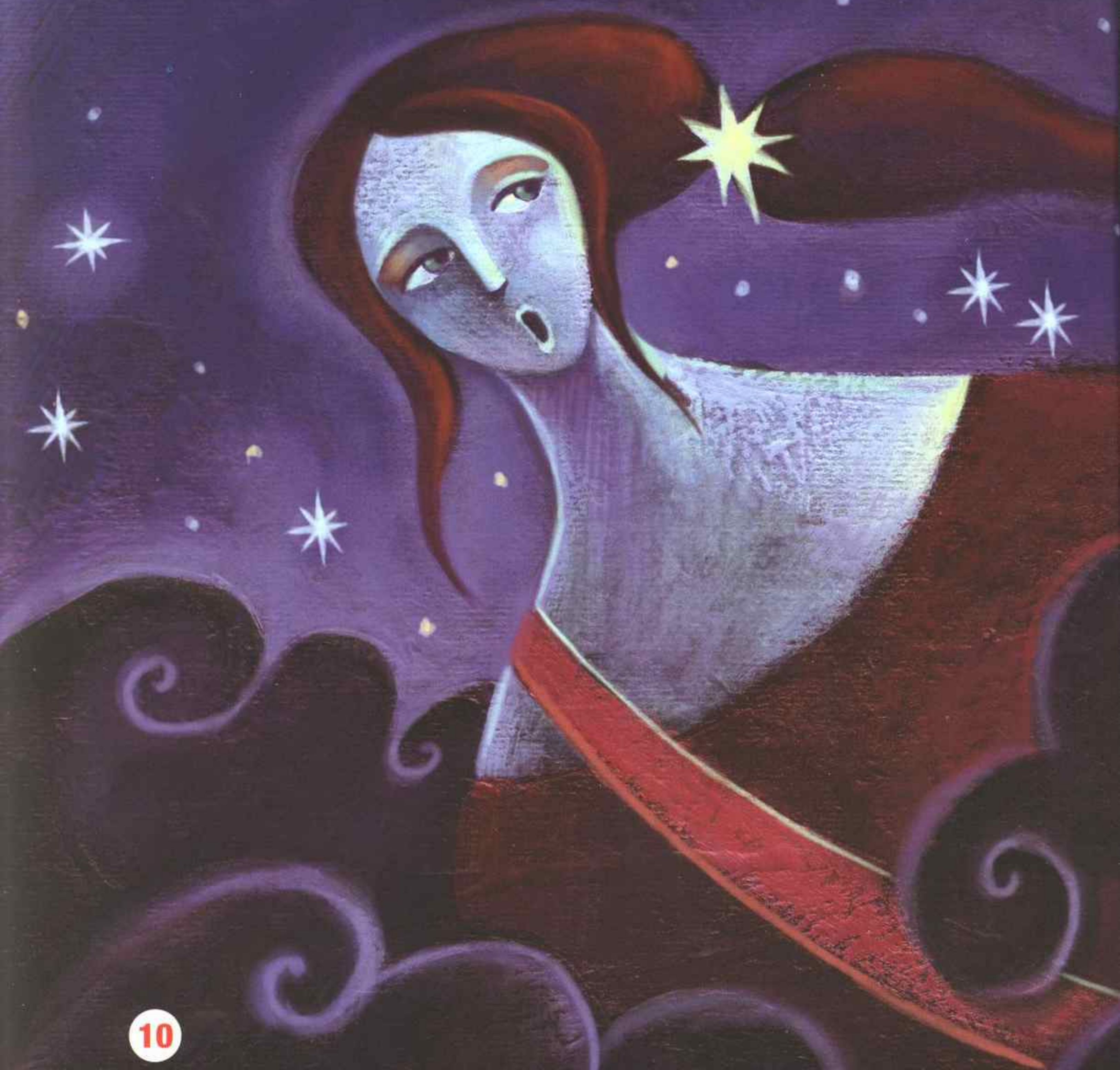
They come fast.

It's very, very dark.

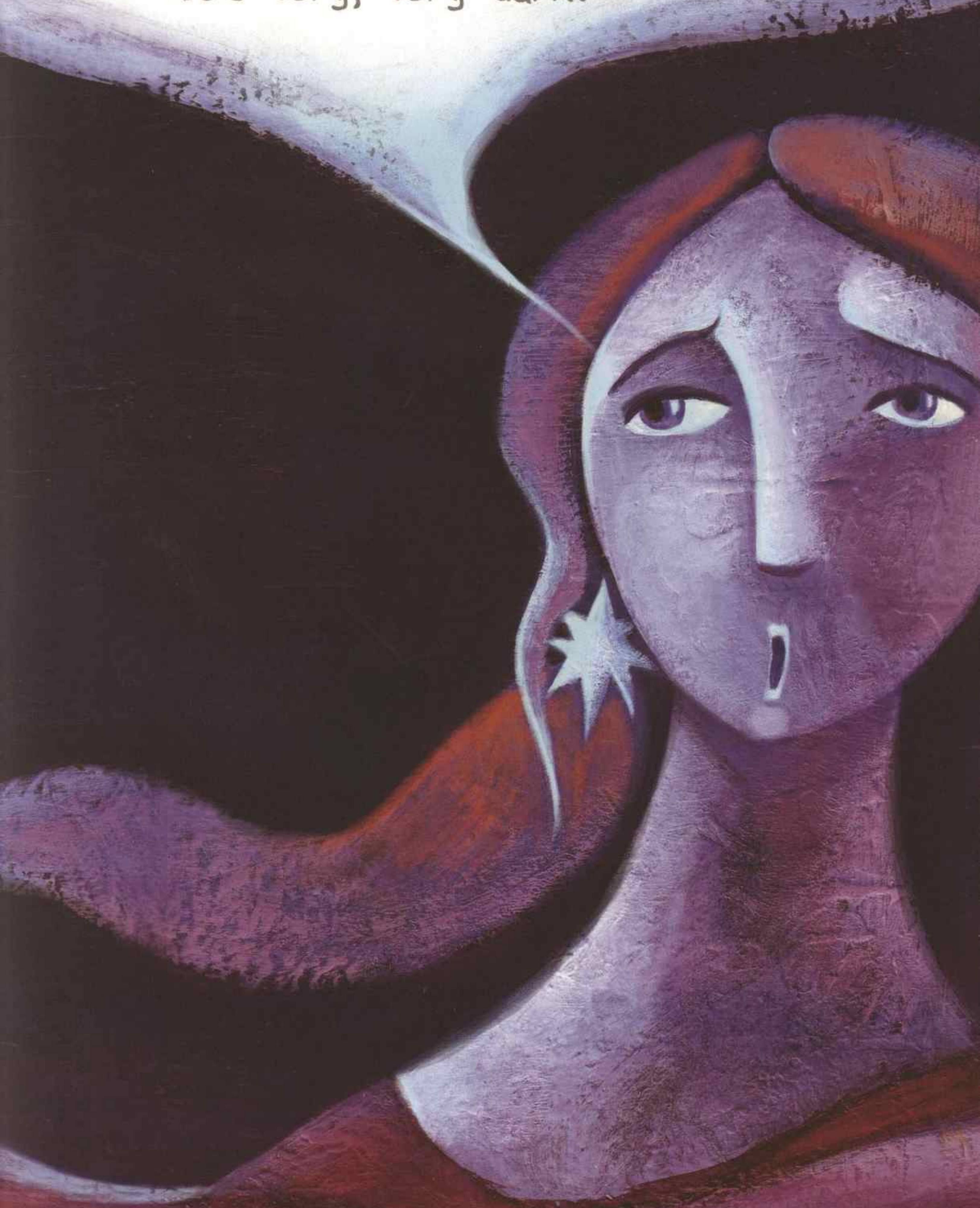
Where is the moon?

Where are the stars?

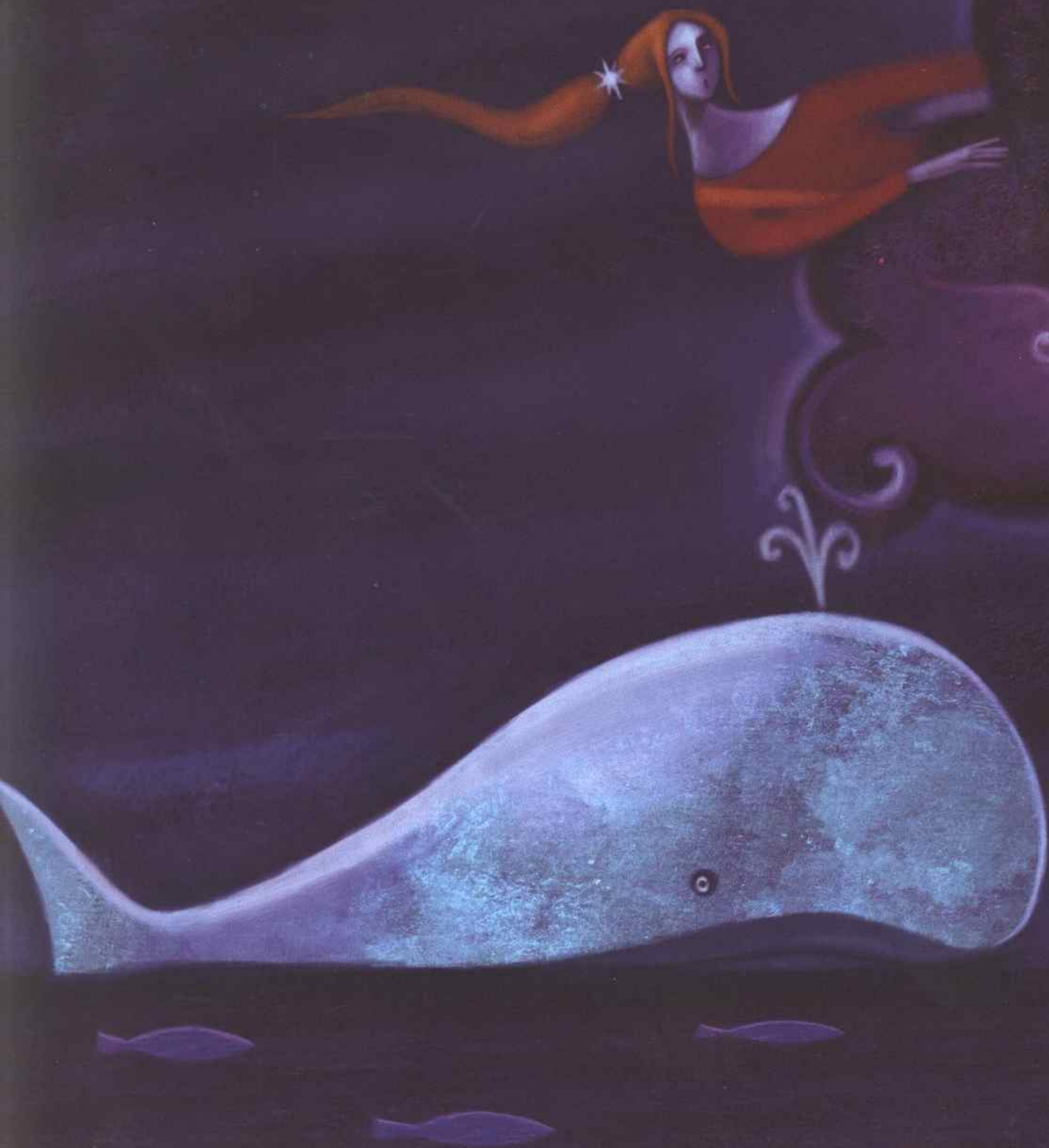
The sky is sad.

Ouch! Ouch! Mosquitoes on my toes!

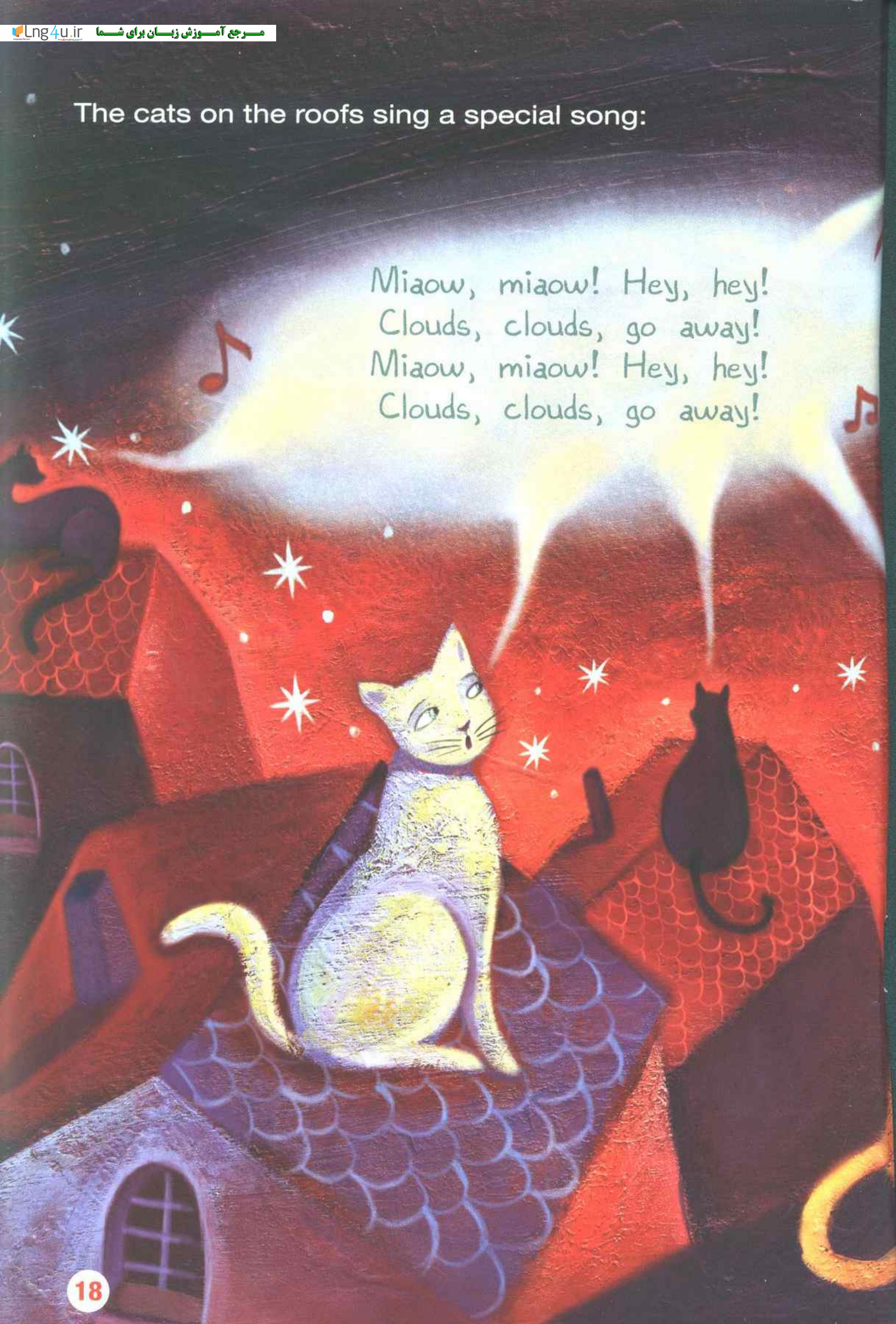


Yuk! Yuk!

Clouds, clouds, go away!



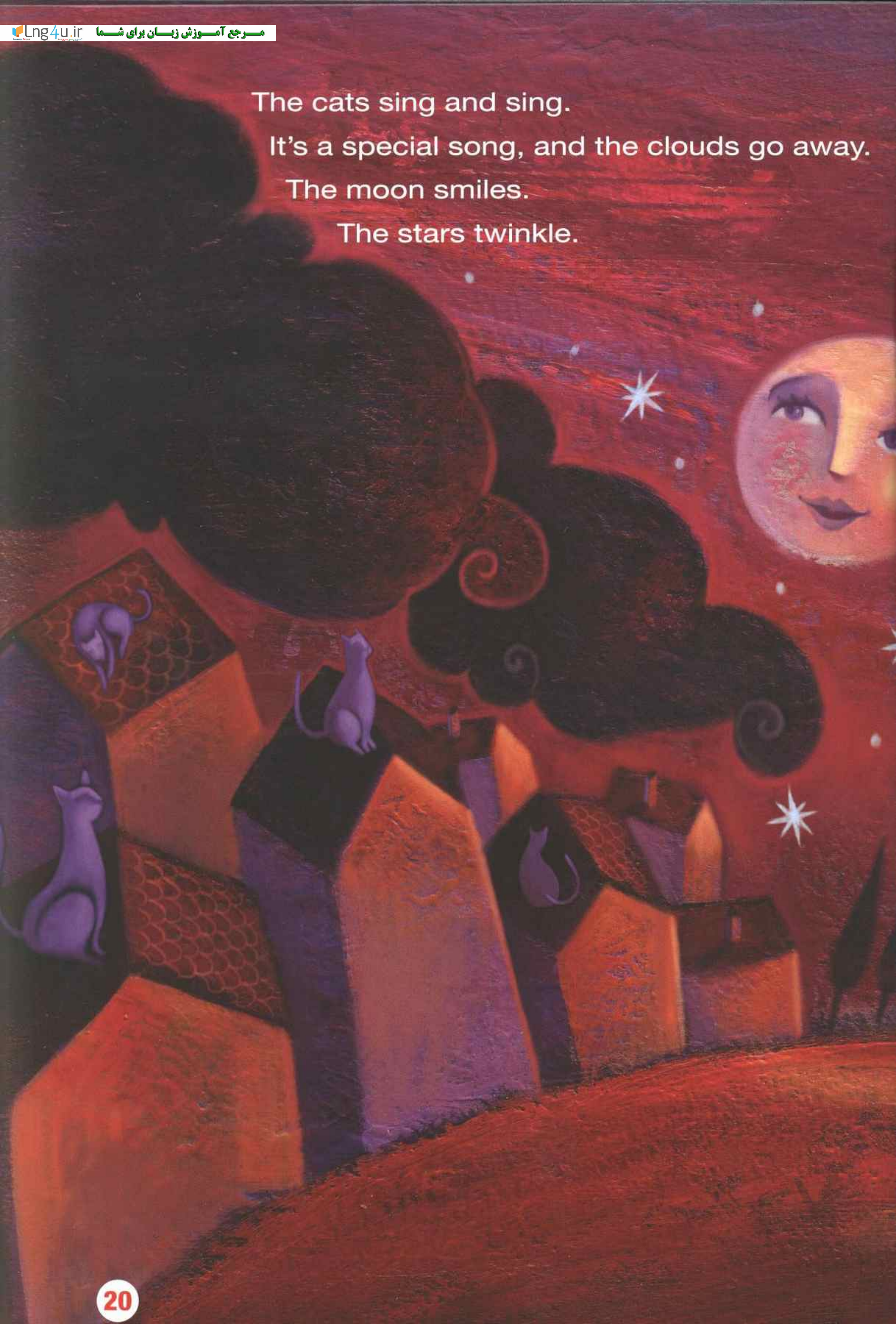


The cats sing and sing.

2 Colour the stars yellow.



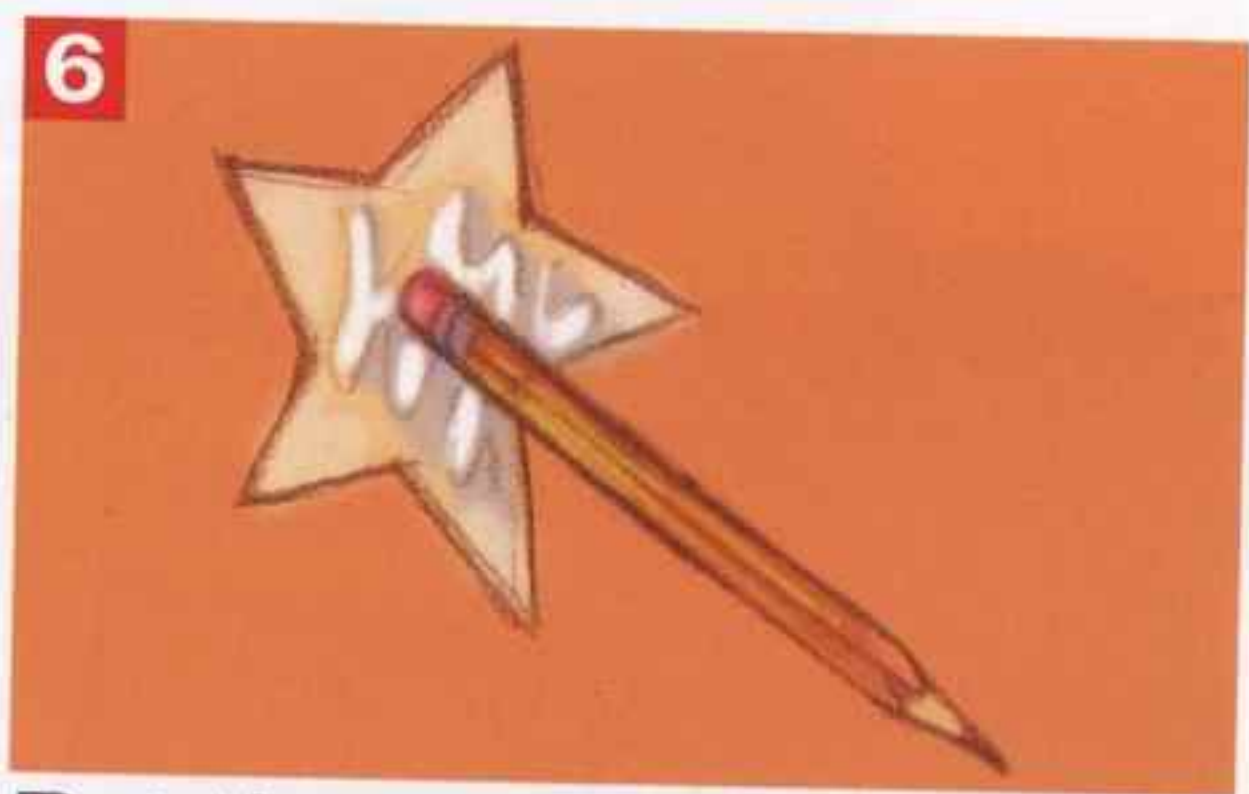
3 Cut out the stars.

8 Press and count to 10. Your magic pencil is ready!
